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Champagne & Sparkling

- Taittinger, Brut Reserve, France** 175
Golden yellow color with a consistent, fine, lingering mousse. The nose is light and delicate with hints of fruits and brioche. The palate is lean but has considerable depth and elegance with a long fresh finish
- Taittinger, Brut Reserve, half bottle** 92
- Taittinger, Brut Prestige Rosé, France** 210
The nose is strong and expressive, characterized by the aroma of freshly crushed wild strawberries, cherries and blackcurrants. The addition of its delicate bubbles brings four words to mind: vibrancy, fruitiness, freshness, and acidity
- Bollinger, Rosé, France** 198
A subtle combination of structure, length and vivacity, with a tannic finish due to the adjunction of red wine Bubbles as fine as velvet Flavors of wild berries
- Prosecco Sartori Erfo, Treviso, Italy** 52
A nice, delicate fruit bouquet, reminiscent of wild apples and acacia flowers; dry with subtle fruit and nut flavors.
- Pasqua, Romeo & Juliet Prosecco Rose, Italy** 55
The elegance of Glera enhanced by the structure of Pinot Nero. This Prosecco Rose has a coppery color and a refined bouquet. The palate is fresh and fruity with attractive scents of raspberries.
- Villa Sandi, Asolo Prosecco Superiore, Italy** 58
Aromas of fresh grapes, green apple, lime and grassy notes. Light palate, a soft mousse, rounded texture and acidity with a light supple finish.

Chardonnay

Wente Morning Fog, Central Coast, California 55

Aromas and flavors of green apple and tropical fruits, balanced by subtle oak, cinnamon and vanilla from barrel aging.

Montes Alpha, Casablanca Valley, Chile 59

Papaya and pineapple with hints of banana, linden blossom, hazelnut and nutmeg. Ample and friendly on the palate, this has a creamy feel and a caramel finish.

Kendall Jackson, California 62

Beautifully integrated tropical flavors such as pineapple, mango, and papaya with citrus notes that explode in your mouth. A hint of toasted oak and butter rounds out the long, lingering finish.

Kunde, Sonoma County, California 64

Aromas of marzipan, crème brûlée, and orange blossom. Flavors of lemon custard, toasted butterscotch, and golden apple.

Pomino, Frescobaldi, Tuscany 65

Surprising fragrances of white flowers on the nose such as lily of the valley and jasmine, followed by scents of white-flesh fruit like apple and passion fruit.

Sea Sun By Caymus, California 75

From the Wagner Family, makers of Caymus. A round, creamy Chardonnay with flavors of lemon, cinnamon and oak

El Enemigo, Mendoza, Argentina 81

Beautiful wine with a dense palate of ripe lemons and apples. Layered and refined with phenolic tension. Complex yeast and hints of oak and flor

Diatom by Brewer Clifton, Santa Barbara County 92

Unoaked, stainless steel fermented wine. Aromas of lemon, citrus blossom and wet sand. On the palate, saline and white peach.

Robert Mondavi, Napa Valley, California 96

Aromas of sun-ripened pineapple and lemon crème are layered by flavors of guava, Asian pear, and zesty grapefruit all integrated with a toasty complexity.

- Planeta, Sicily D.O.C., Italy** 97
Stone fruit and acacia honey, with a toasted and vanilla touch.
A powerful line of acidity and a mineral character well balanced with its fruity notes.
- Chablis, Louis Latour, Burgundy, France** 102
Attractive lemon, honey and mineral aromas.
Flavors balanced and charming.
- Pouilly Fuissé, Louis Latour, Burgundy** 109
Beautiful white fruit aromas that mix very-well with fine almond notes. There are also Muscat-like aromatics that can be smelt and which linger in the mouth.
- Emblem by Michael Mondavi, Petaluma Gap** 116
Silky stone fruit, lemon curd and honeydew flavors flow across the round, full palate, with lightly toasted oak, cool minerality and a lingering citrus note adding texture and depth.
- Jordan, Russian River Valley, California** 125
Elegant yet succulent, with layers of oak-laced lemon, pears, quince, and white peach, supported by uplifting acidity. Its crisp, citrusy finish entices you to take another sip.
- Mannequin, Orin Swift Collection, California** 127
Consists of ripe white peach and a bold Werther's Original entry and a layered mid-palate of nectarines, pineapple and honey. A touch of green apple and wet stone culminate in a concise crème brulee finish
- Paul Hobbs, Russian River Valley, California** 157
Scents of dried leaves, hay, and almonds with spicy notes and a core of honeyed white peaches. Medium-bodied and refreshing, with flavors of apple and honey
- Catena Zapata, Adriana Vineyard, Mendoza** 199
Aromas of citrus and white fruit with vanilla. The palate is rich & concentrated, showing ripe pear, apple and apricot with salty notes. Clean acidity and length on the finish.
- Meursault, Louis Latour, Cotes de Beaune** 237
A bouquet of toasted almonds, honey and candied lemon. In the mouth, there are aromas of acacia honey and vanilla notes. It is a powerful and round wine

Sauvignon Blanc

Misty Cove, Marlborough, New Zealand 45

Green and flinty in style. This wine is dry, fresh, youthful and aromatic with a hint of tropical fruit and a touch of lime zest. The finish to this wine has a vibrant minerality

Wente, Central Coast, California 55

Fresh aromatics from flint, guava to wet stone, balanced by notes of mandarin and lime zest. This wine has a beautiful and lean minerality, bright acidity and a lingering finish.

Kim Crawford, Marlborough, New Zealand 62

Ripe stone fruit, citrus and tropical flavors mingle with the soothing herb notes.

Honig, Napa County 68

Aromas of grapefruit, lemongrass and lime, overlaying passion fruit and mango characters.

Glaser & Glaser, Kostträumer, Austria 68

Bright yellow with a shade of green made up of luscious gooseberries and exotic fruits, the palate is underlaid with a fresh green aroma and a long persistence.

Sancerre, M. Girault, France 75

Clear pale gold color. Concentrated nose with notes of citrus and exotic fruits with full aromas, a crisp acidity, and finesse in the mouth

Duckhorn Vineyards, Napa Valley 80

A smooth-textured entry gives way to tingling acidity that shows off the citrus elements beautifully, while adding length to flavors of cantaloupe, Asian pear and Fuji apple. The finish is persistent and refreshing with long mineral notes.

Sancerre La Poussie, France 95

This wine shows clean, intense citrus, apple and mineral flavors finishing with a tangy, high-toned, cleanly balanced acidity.

Cakebread Cellars, Napa Valley 109

The startlingly fresh, vivid aromas literally leap out of the glass, redolent of just-cut white grapefruit and, bracing gooseberry. On the palate, the melon, green apple and mineral flavors are remarkably rich, concentrated and vibrant, with a long, full finish.

Pinot Grigio

Santa Cristina, Delle Venezie, Italy 47

A full-bodied flavor while remaining soft on the palate. It has good acidity and a lasting finish which recalls the citrus notes that were first introduced to the nose.

Elena Walch, Alto Adige, Italy (Staff Favorite) 62

light straw yellow and fruity notes of ripe pears, white pepper and a bit of sage in the nose. Mineral- salty richness and a crisp acidity are distinctive on the palate.

A to Z, Oregon 70

Refreshing and lithe on the palate. Aromas of Meyer lemon, lemon verbena, tangerine, apricot, peach, apple, pear, quince, melon and honeysuckle add a hint of sweetness to the air around it.

La Crema, Monterey, California 72

Aromas of pear, lemon curd, pineapple, and white floral notes, with flavors of Meyer lemon and nectarine are followed by a fresh yet rich and multilayered acidity.

Blush

Cote des Roses, Languedoc, France (Staff Favorite) 56

The bouquet releases aromas of summer fruits, cassis, and redcurrant. Floral notes of rose along with hints of grapefruit complete the picture. The finish is fresh, offering notes of candy.

Kim Crawford, South Island, New Zealand 62

Soft and luscious, this refreshing Rose is richly fruited with hints of watermelon and strawberry

Miraval, Cotes de Provence, France 69

A beautiful light pink colour, fresh fruit aromas and refreshing acidity. Miraval's pure expression of the terroir of Cotes de Provence. A delicious wine made by Brad Pitt & Angelina Jolie.

Whispering Angel, Cotes de Provence, France 70

The palest of pale roses, a silver-pink, lovely fragrance on the nose, clean and fresh light summer fruits, a certain fleshiness on the palate that shows the red grapes base.

Interesting Whites

- Protos Verdejo, Rueda, Spain** 45
Powerful, fruity with green apple, citrus and tropical fruits, fragrant herbs and fennel hints.
- Gerard Neumeyer Pinot Blanc, Alsace, France** 54
Fresh green apples, lemon zest & nectarines.
Minerality comes out from the limestone.
- Domaine Neumeyer, Riesling, Alsace, France** 57
This dry Riesling has a clear yellow body with citrus scents on the nose. In the mouth, it has a beautiful continuity of citrus fruits, supported by light flexibility and a long finale
- Dr. Konstantin, Riesling, Finger Lakes, New York** 61
Semi dry Riesling with an expressive style with dominant characters of grapefruit, lime and fruit notes. All elements are perfectly balanced.
- Bolgheri, Vermentino, Tuscany, Italy** 62
This wine shows a fresh nose with aromatic notes which recall citrus fruit and flowers. The flavors are fruity and are well supported by the acidity and by mineral sensations which add savor, length and vigor.
- Glaser & Glaser Grüner Veltliner, Austria** 67
Elegant, bright, straw-yellow color is complemented with an aroma of green apple and finished with white pepper.
- Conundrum, White Blend, California** 75
Scents of apricot, pineapple, honeysuckle and coconut. A creamy and soft entry, with lush flavors of Asian pear, Hawaiian fruit, apricot and brown spice.
- Albariño, La Marimorena, Rias Baixas, Spain** 79
Intense and complex nose with notes of fruits such as apple, peach, and pineapple with light notes of white flowers. Fresh and pleasant acidity, reminding of green fruits
- Stags' Leap, Viognier, Napa Valley** 100
Crisp and multi-layered with notes of orange blossom, nectarine, peach Tarte Tatin and Asian pear, alongside more delicate hints of toasted almond, allspice and honeysuckle.

Cabernet Sauvignon

- J. Lohr, Seven Oaks, Paso Robles** 67
Ripe aromas of black cherry and currant followed by notes of hazelnut and vanilla.
- Bonanza By Caymus, California** (Staff Favorite) 75
Features flavors of luscious fruit, dark chocolate and silky tannins
- LUI by Pasqua, Veneto, Italy** 80
Very soft and velvety tannins mouthfeel and aftertaste of coconut, vanilla, dried fruit with a long finish and light smoky notes. Aged in French Cognac oak barrels.
- Kunde, Sonoma County** 84
Black cherry, raspberry and spice flavors that linger.
- Oberon by Michael Mondavi, Napa County** 86
Deep colors, supple silky tannins, vibrant black cherry, candied blackberry and spices. A hint of coffee and dark chocolate creates a lingering and delightful finish.
- Greenwing By Duckhorn, Columbia Valley** 89
Layers of black plum, cherry pie and spice that linger throughout a long, rich finish.
- Canvasback By Duckhorn, Red Mountain, WA** 108
Hints of caramel and espresso from barrel aging. The entry is supple, weighty, and rounded, with deliciously ripe tannins and juicy acidity coming
- Palermo By Orin Swift, Napa Valley** 163
Classic and traditional left Bank Bordeaux-style. Ripe cassis, blackberry and assorted blue fruits with a touch of chapparal.
- Jordan, Alexander Valley** 192
Concentrated aromas of blackberry, blueberry, and cassis. The soft, round tannins and understated acidity of this wine complement the bright fruit characters
- Freemark Abbey, Napa Valley** (Sommeliers Favorite) 203
Black currant and dark chocolate with cinnamon on the nose. Full cherry-berry flavor over a bed of resolved tannins. A very inviting wine, full flavored from start to finish.
- Cakebread Cellars, Napa Valley** 248
Dark cherry, boysenberry, blackcurrant and black fig aromas, with scents of oak toast, dark chocolate and fresh cherry.,
- Silverado Solo, Stags Leap District, Napa Valley** 300
Medium body with lush but not overripe fruit. Aromas of plum and cherry with earth and herb notes in the back.

Malbec

Pascual Toso Reserva, Mendoza, Argentina 54

Hand harvested in small baskets; selected grapes are used for this wine. It is round and inviting, firm around the edges, but there is plenty of fruit to enjoy.

Catena, Mendoza, Argentina 62

A rich, concentrated mouthfeel is highlighted by flavors of blueberries and blackberries with a touch of leather and cinnamon

Felino by Paul Hobbs, Mendoza, Argentina 64

Violet red with black tones. Aromas of fresh black fruits and prunes. The palate displays good concentration, balance and sweet yet supple tannins.

El Enemigo, Mendoza, Argentina 82

Aromas of black fruit, cherry, and dark berries. A full-bodied wine with flavors of spice, blackberry, black cherry, and pepper. The finish is elegant and lengthy

Luca, Uco Valley, Mendoza, Argentina (Owners Favorite) 92

Opaque purple color with a nose of sandalwood, Asian spices, lavender, black cherry, and plum. It combines power and elegance. Smooth-textured, spicy, full, and rich

Bramare by Paul Hobbs, Mendoza, Argentina 108

Aromas of ripe red and black fruit mixed with spicy notes of vanilla, clove, cinnamon, and cigar box. Hints of confectionery. Concentrated palate with sweet tannins and a velvety texture. It is beautifully balanced with a persistent finish.

Catena Alta, Mendoza, Argentina 152

Full and rich with soft, sweet tannins and a silky-smooth structure. Multiple layers of rich cassis, black currant, and berries with hints of licorice and black pepper

- HobNob Cellars, Pays D'Oc, France** 44
As elegant as a bouquet of violets and bursting with cherry flavors, the Pinot Noir is medium-bodied with soft tannins, to create a smooth, rich texture.
- Meiomi, California** 68
Fruit aromas of bright strawberry and jammy fruit, mocha, vanilla, and toasty oak.
- Elouan, Oregon State** 69
Aromas of dried cherries and blackberry, high fruit notes with hints of vanilla and clove spice
- Rodney Strong, Russian River Valley** 69
Aromas of plum, brown sugar and baked fruit
- Wente, Riva Ranch, Central Coast, California** 70
Youthful aromas of ripe Rainier cherries, raspberries, smoked nuts, and toasted brioche with a delicate layer of sweet vanilla oak.
- Duckhorn Migration, Sonoma Coast** 106
Impressive volume, with abundant cherry pie and strawberry flavors and a note of spiced orange peel, all framed by just a touch of sweet, toasty new French oak.
- WillaKenzie, Willamette Valley, Oregon** 130
Notes of boysenberry, blackberry, and red raspberry. Those flavors carry through to a juicy and intense palate that finishes with great vibrancy, purity, and length.
- Hartford Court, Russian River Valley, California** 136
Aromas of black cherry, allspice and black currant are followed by flavors of wild raspberries and dark berries.
- Slander By Orin Swift, California** 156
Aromatics of bright strawberry, candied cherry, crushed gravel, wet brick, white pepper and brushed violet.
- Pommard, Domaine Des Riottes, Burgundy, France** 161
Earthy, smooth & silky, bright cherry flavor with some darker currant and plum flavors.
- Flowers Vineyards, Sonoma Coast, California** 166
Flavors of cherry, raspberry, and pomegranate are framed by fine-grained tannins, coastal minerality, and bright acidity that culminate in the lengthy finish

Interesting Reds

- Rioja, Crianza, Marqués de Cáceres, Spain** 55
Bright, cherry- red color. Mature fruit flavors that highlight its pleasant fullness.
- Merlot, Wente, Sandstone, Livermore Valley** 59
Aromas and flavors of black cherry, blackberry and plum with hints of toasted oak. A smooth mouthfeel and inviting tannins lead to a long, fruity finish.
- Chianti, Classico, Peppoli, Italy** 68
Intense fruity notes of cherries and red currants on the nose fuse very well with sensations of violets of Chianti Classico. Balanced acidity with silky and polished tannins
- Barbera d’Alba, Tre Vigne, Vietti, Italy** 72
Slightly rounder than the Barbera d’Asti, it shows bright acidity on the palate, soft tannins with good integration of oak, good complexity, and a lingering cherry finish.
- Zinfandel, Seghesio, Sonoma County** 90
Offers tantalizing raspberry, blueberry, classic briary, and spicy flavors with a balance of components for which Seghesio wines are known
- Zinfandel, 8 Years In The Desert, Napa Valley** 138
Stewed plums, baked raspberries and fruitcake with hints of powdered cinnamon, clove oil, tree bark, hoisin and dusty soil. Medium to full-bodied, the palate is chock-full of ripe, spicy black and red fruits.
- Merlot, Duckhorn Vineyards, Napa Valley** 150
Aromas of ripe cherry and black raspberry. Luxurious flavors of black plum, rhubarb crumble, and chocolate-covered raspberry make for a long vibrant finish
- Masi, Costasera, Amarone Classico, Veneto, Italy** 163
Powerful, complex aromas of dried plums and balsamic (anise, fennel, mint) traces. Quite dry (not sweet) on the palate, soft and with bright acidity, the wine shows flavors of baked cherry, chocolate and cinnamon.
- Barolo, Prunotto, Piedmonte, Italy** 172
The nose is complex and generous with pleasing notes of violets, raspberry, cedar and cassis. On the palate it is well balanced with velvety tannins.
- Brunello Di Montalcino, Pian delle Vigne, Italy** 180
Fabulous aromas of plums, prunes, Christmas pudding, and berries. Full-bodied, ultra-fine tannins and a long and intense finish. Polished and refined

Meritages / Red Blends

- 689 Cellars, Napa Valley** 69
Abundant amounts of bright red fruits, followed by layers of black cherry, wild berry and black licorice. The sexy finish highlights soft and sweet tannins with a hint of spice.
- Villa Antinori, Tuscany, Italy** 70
Sangiovese-based, it's smooth oaked, displaying flavors of cassis, red cherry and Mediterranean herbs supported by fine-boned tannins and refreshing acidity.
- Decoy by Duckhorn, California** 75
Aromas of blackberry, plum, dark red fruit, and cranberry, with hints of caramel, and exotic spices.
- Murrieta's Well, The Spur, Livermore Valley** 96
Aromas and flavors of vanilla, spiced cranberry, and clove with the perfect balance of graham cracker and plum followed by assertive tannins and an elegant mouthfeel

Zin driven blend with enticing aromas of cherry and espresso. Flavors of ripe raspberry, pomegranate and wild berry linger harmoniously for a smooth and luscious finish

Dark garnet Zin blend with a nose of ripe black cherry and plum, wintergreen and beautiful oak spice. Deep and sensuously layered with polished tannins, river-rock minerality, and a long finish.

A complex mix of aromas including raspberry, black pepper, violets, cloves and subtle notes of dark chocolate.
- Tignanello, Antinori, Tuscany** 357
Cab Driven. Fantastic aromas of dark berries, sandalwood, and Spanish cedar that are so deep. Full-bodied, with incredibly polished tannins, bright acidity, and great depth

Pascal Jolivet, Sancerre, France 46

Fresh, clean and screaming with racy acidity. On the palate it is fresh and tightly wound; very clean; alive, racy, youthful. A beautifully balanced, elegant wine.

Louis Latour, Pouilly Fuissé, Burgundy, France 57

Beautiful white fruit aromas that mix very-well with fine almond notes. There are also Muscat-like aromatics that can be smelt and which linger in the mouth.

Small Bottles Red

Marques de Caceres, Rioja Crianza, Spain 32

Bright, deep ruby red color. Intense bouquet that reveals notes of sweet spice with a depth of vanilla and red ruby fruit. Full in the mouth with ripe tannins.

Kendall Jackson Cabernet, Vinter's reserve 44

Aromas of lush black cherry, blackberry and cassis draw you in. Round and rich tannins provide a robust backbone and supple mid-palate. Notes of cedar, vanilla and a hint of mocha linger on the finish.

Zinfandel, Seghesio, Sonoma County 49

Offers tantalizing raspberry, blueberry, classic briary, and spicy flavors with a balance of components for which Seghesio wines are known

La Crema, Pinot Noir, Sonoma Coast, California 50

Aromas of pomegranate and sweet tobacco, followed by flavors of berries and plums with subtle hints of spice and toast. Well-balanced acidity & fine tannins for a long finish

Tommasi, Amarone Della Valpolicella, Italy 79

Accents of thyme, pomegranate and espresso. full-bodied with good acidity.

Consists of ripe white peach and a bold Werther's Original entry and a layered mid-palate of nectarines, pineapple and honey. A touch of green apple and wet stone culminate in a concise crème brulee finish

Abstract, Red Blend, California

138

Black plum, boysenberry and hints of bing cherry and lavender invite a taste. On the palate, the aromatics turn into the sense of taste along with a touch of dark chocolate and reduced blackberry. Supple drying tannins and a slight chalky texture close the wine with a calming finish.

8 Years In The Desert, Zinfandel, Napa Valley

138

Notes of stewed plums, baked raspberries and fruitcake with hints of powdered cinnamon, clove oil, tree bark, hoisin and dusty soil. Medium to full-bodied, the palate is chock-full of ripe, spicy black and red fruits, supported by chewy tannins and tons of freshness, finishing long and earthy.

Slander, Pinot Noir, California

156

The wine opens with no-fuss aromatics of bright strawberry, candied cherry, crushed gravel, wet brick, white pepper and brushed violet. Enveloping in a sophisticated, elegant manner, the palate has similar tones to the nose with some black cherry and a touch of minerality. Vibrant and energetic through the finish, the wine closes with a pleasant vein of acidity, capable of myriad pairings.

Palermo, Cabernet Sauvignon, Napa Valley

Classic and traditional Left Bank Bordeaux-style nose of ripe cassis, blackberry and assorted blue fruits with a touch of chapparal. The entry is robust with notes of blackberry pie, black cherry, and impressive weight. Soft tannins and a bright finish round out the wine with a lingering touch of orange peel.

Papillon, Bordeaux Blend, Napa Valley

Aromas of ripe boysenberry, kirsch, mixed dark berry pie, and coastal sagebrush. A plush palate, with dense tannins, notes of blackberry, black licorice, and ripe plum
